

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on October 3, 2024, a public hearing as required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the “Code”) will be held telephonically with respect to the proposal of The Centurion Foundation, Inc., a Georgia nonprofit corporation and an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code (together with any parent, subsidiary, or other affiliate, the “Borrower”), that the National Finance Authority (the “Authority”) issue its revenue bonds in one or more series in an amount not to exceed \$31,000,000 (the “Bonds”). The proceeds of the Bonds will be used by the Borrower to: (1) finance the acquisition of a medical office and healthcare facility located at 6101 Woodway Drive, Woodway, Texas (the “Project”); and (2) pay certain expenses incurred in connection with the issuance of the Bonds. Upon acquisition, the Project will be leased to Ascension Providence, a Texas nonprofit corporation and an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code (together with any parent, subsidiary, or other affiliate, “Providence”). The Project will be owned by the Borrower and operated by Providence in accordance with their charitable purposes.

The Bonds and the obligation to pay principal of and interest thereon and any redemption premium with respect thereto do not constitute indebtedness or an obligation of the City of Woodway, Texas, the County of McLennan, Texas, the State of Texas, the Authority, the State of New Hampshire, or any political subdivision thereof, within the meaning of any constitutional or statutory debt limitation, or a charge against the general credit or taxing powers of any of them. The Bonds shall be a limited obligation of the Authority, payable solely from certain revenues duly pledged therefor and generally representing amounts paid by the Borrower.

The telephonic public hearing will be held at 4:00pm. Interested persons wishing to express their views on the issuance of the Bonds or on the nature and location of the Project proposed to be financed may participate in the telephonic public hearing by calling the telephonic conference line, 844-854-2222 (a toll-free telephone number) and entering the participant code 920111 or, prior to the time of the hearing, submit written comments to the address below.
