Approve a final resolution (Resolution 25-35) to issue up to \$36,000,000 in revenue bonds for the National Finance Authority (Centurion Foundation Wilkens Avenue, LLC), located in the State of Maryland.

Motion by Key-Wallace Seconded by Benson; Motion carries by 3-0 vote, without abstentions.

Approve a final resolution (Resolution 25-36) to issue up to \$70,000,000 in revenue bonds for the National Finance Authority (Beacon Health Energy Projects), Series 2025A, located in the State of Indiana.

Motion by Benson Seconded by Key-Wallace; Motion carries by 3-0 vote, without abstentions.

Approve an initial resolution (Resolution 25-37) to issue up to \$500,000,000 in tax-exempt and/or taxable revenue bonds for the National Finance Authority (Springfield Regional Justice Center Project), located in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Motion by Key-Wallace Seconded by Benson; Motion carries by 3-0 vote, without abstentions.
