Approve a final resolution (Resolution 26-36) to issue up to \$275,000,000 in special revenue capital appreciation bonds for the National Finance Authority (Howard Hughes Bridgeland 3) Series 2026, located in the State of Texas.

Approve a final resolution (Resolution 26-37) to issue up to \$83,000,000 in residential development revenue bonds for the National Finance Authority (Crest at Brier Creek Apartments), Series 2026, located in the State of North Carolina.

Approve a final resolution (Resolution 26-38) to issue up to \$135,000,000 in taxable revenue bonds for the National Finance Authority (South Loop Investments Project), Series 2026, located in the State of Minnesota.
Motion by Provencher Seconded by Key-Wallace; Motion carries by 5-0 vote, without abstentions.
