Approve a final resolution (Resolution 26-40) to issue up to \$125,000,000 in special revenue capital appreciation bonds for the National Finance Authority (LGI Homes Projects, Collin, Fort Bend, Harris, Hood, Montgomery and Waller Counties, Texas), Series 2026, located in the State of Texas.

Motion by Duprey Seconded by Key-Wallace; Motion carries by 4-0 vote, without abstentions.

Approve a final resolution (Resolution 26-41) to issue up to \$80,000,000 in special revenue bonds for the National Finance Authority (Beazer Municipal Utility District Projects, Brazoria, Fort Bend, Galveston, Harris, and Montgomery Counties, Texas), Series 2026, located in the State of Texas.

Motion by Duprey to include capital appreciation bonds, Seconded by Key-Wallace; Motion carries by 4-0 vote, without abstentions.

Approve a final resolution (Resolution 26-42) to issue up to \$140,000,000 in senior living revenue bonds for the National Finance Authority (Glenhaven Housing Foundation Project), Series 2026, located in the State of Missouri.
